Be a part of the annual *Skating Spectacular on Ice*. The Skating Show is a **great opportunity for developing skaters to get extra ice time and apply their skating skills in new ways!**

The Show will be a fundraiser for the Children's Hospital at Dartmouth-Hitchcock (CHaD), with at least 50% of net proceeds donated to CHaD. Over the last two-years, we've raised over \$23,000 for CHaD, including Positive Tracks' (CHaD's funding partner) matching contribution.

The show will feature:

- Group numbers featuring SCAD Pre-School, Basic Skills, Hockey and Freestyle skaters
- Solos by some of the Skating Club's freestyle skaters*
- Speed Skating demonstration by several former US Olympians and SCAD Speed Skaters
- Guest performances by regional and national figure skating competitors

Who can participate?

All Fall 1, Fall 2 and/or Winter skaters are invited to participate. New Spring session skaters should email Jacki Smith (sk8info@skatingclubatdartmouth.org) to discuss if they are ready to participate.

What do you need to do?

- Attend **all** show practices, the dress rehearsal and the Show.
- Pay a participation fee, which will be used to cover ice time and costumes:
 - o \$50 for Pre-School, Basic Skills and/or Freestyle (Family discount: \$40 for 2nd+ skaters)
 - o \$30 for Hockey Edge and Speed Skating skaters
 - o Group number skaters will be provided with a costume at dress rehearsal. Pant and shirt color guidelines will be provided well in advance.

Lead-up to and Day of Show Help

Please sign-up for two (2) or more roles via online registration when you register your child for the Show

<u>Role</u>	<u>Description</u>
Advertising & Poster Distribution	Help us get the word out! ~2 weeks before the show, hang posters around the Upper Valley. We will provide posters to all skater families for distribution.
Ticket Sales	Help with ticket sales at Show rehearsals and on the day-of the Show.
Raffle Ticket Sales	Help with raffle ticket sales events at the Coop and outreach to neighbors, friends & family. There will be a raffle ticket sales contest for skaters.
Bake Sale Help	Bring baked goods or other goodies for sale during the Show. Help with Bake Show sales efforts during the Show.
Group Number Point Person	Assigned point person for one of the group numbers. Check-in assigned skaters at Dress Rehearsal and Show. Sit with that group in the stands and escort them to/from the locker room for their number and the finale.
Runners & Locker room helpers	Help skaters backstage in either the first or second half of the Show, including getting skaters to/from the ice for their number & finale.
Stage Set-up	Help at the Dress Rehearsal and Show with backstage setup and clean-up.
Clean-up	Help with clean-up after the Show (~30 minutes post-Show).
