Be a part of the annual *Skating Spectacular on Ice*. The Skating Show is a **great opportunity for developing skaters to get extra ice time and apply their skating skills in new ways!**

**The Show will be a fundraiser for the Ice Vets sled hockey**, with at least 50% of net proceeds being donated to the organization which provides adaptive sports opportunities for disabled veterans. Over the last three-years, we've raised over \$30,000 for CHaD, including Positive Tracks' (CHaD's funding partner) matching contribution and so this year we decided to provide for a different local organization.

**The show will feature:**

- Group numbers featuring SCAD Pre-School, Basic Skills, and Freestyle skaters
- Solos by some of the Skating Club's freestyle skaters\*
- Guest performances by regional and national figure skating competitors

**Who can participate?**

All Fall 1, Fall 2 and/or Winter skaters are invited to participate. New Spring session skaters should email Jacki Smith ([sk8info@skatingclubatdartmouth.org](mailto:sk8info@skatingclubatdartmouth.org)) to discuss if they are ready to participate.

**What do you need to do?**

- Attend **all** show practices, the dress rehearsal and the Show.
- Pay a participation fee, which will be used to cover ice time and costumes:
  - o \$50 for Pre-School, Basic Skills and/or Freestyle (Family discount: \$40 for 2<sup>nd</sup>+ skaters)
  - o Group number skaters will be provided with a costume to go over the top of your skater's base layer at dress rehearsal. We may require a certain color pant and/or shirt such as black or denim.

\*Solo skaters: we cannot guarantee a solo spot for all interested skaters. The final determination will depend on the number of skaters who register, with any cut-offs determined by a skater's test level.

### Lead-up to and Day of Show Help

<u>Role</u>	<u>Description</u>
Advertising & Poster Distribution	Help us get the word out! ~2 weeks before the show, hang posters around the Upper Valley. We will provide posters to all skater families for distribution.
Ticket Sales	Help with ticket sales at Show rehearsals and on the day-of the Show.
Bake Sale Help	Bring baked goods or other goodies for sale during the Show. Help with Bake Show sales efforts during the Show.
Group Number Point Person	Assigned point person for one of the group numbers. Check-in assigned skaters at Dress Rehearsal and Show. Sit with that group in the stands and escort them to/from the locker room for their number and the finale.
Runners & Locker room helpers	Help skaters backstage in either the first or second half of the Show, including getting skaters to/from the ice for their number & finale.
Stage Set-up	Help at the Dress Rehearsal and Show with backstage setup and clean-up.
Clean-up	Help with clean-up after the Show (~30 minutes post-Show).
