Who can participate?

All skaters who are registered for our 2025 Spring Session.

What do you need to do?

- Skaters must attend 2 out of the 3 show practices for their level, the dress rehearsal, and the Skating Show (see Practice and Performance Schedule below).
- Pay a participation fee, which will be used to cover ice time, T-shirts and costumes:
 - \$80 for Pre-School, Basic Skills and/or Freestyle Skaters, sibling discount, 5.00 off after first skater. Must enroll at same time.
 - Group number skaters will be provided with a costume at dress rehearsal. Pant and shirt color guidelines will be provided well in advance.

Any skater who is not able to attend the required practices will not be allowed to participate in the show with no credits or refunds provided.
